Programme Note

Acoustic Sketch is a piece for Brass Band and Carillon. The piece is build on the overtones of a fundamental resulting in an acoustic scale. The idea is that these tones are audible in a bell of the carillon. The chords used in the band try to mimic this sound quality.

Performance Note

The chords in this piece could be preformed as you normally would, however it will probably sound better if the chords are tuned precisely to the harmonic series. That means that the fifth of each chord should be played slightly sharp (2 cents higher) and the third 14 cents lower. The seventh needs to be 31 cents lower and the
